
Also the Publisher appears as a Not trusted. The **odd thing is I'm the Administrator** and I **also changed UAC settings** (User account settings)
but **no luck**. After a 5 days of hard work and it's one of the very
frustrating experience of my life, but finally I found the solution for
this problem. So follow steps carefully to **solve this app has been blocked for your protection error in Windows 10**.

How To Fix this app has been blocked for your protection Error

Problem: The problem of "this app has been blocked for your protection" error is, In Windows 10, the hidden built-in Administrator account available and that account blocked .exe file to run. So first of all, here I enable the hidden administrator account.

Step 1:




